600 Days of Solidarity at NORCOR: Saturday December 22. Called to action by people held by ICE in our local NORCOR jail, activists have been rallying in solidarity since May 1, 2017. Many of you have shown our UU values and brought this congregation's Immigrant Welcoming & Supporting resolution to life by participating in these daily vigils held outside NORCOR.

NORCOR remains the *only* facility in Oregon that has a contract with ICE to hold immigrant detainees, many of whom were residents of Washington state before detention. They continue to be held in inhumane conditions, separated from their families who are regularly denied face-to-face visitation.

Show our support is unwavering by participating in the 601st consecutive day of action. Meet on the corner of W 6th and Webber streets in The Dalles at **noon this Saturday, December 22**. The group will march from there to the grass area outside NORCOR. The rally will finish at 1 p.m. Families are welcome to participate.
