We are called to build community connections, educate ourselves, take action against injustice and division, work for inclusion rather than exclusion, and advocate for human rights on all fronts.

Therefore we declare ourselves an **Immigrant Welcoming and Supporting Congregation** and commit to the following actions:

- We will stand with and support immigrants in our community, and accompany them at their request in immigration-related proceedings.
- We will educate ourselves and our community about immigrationrelated issues, especially the injustices faced by immigrants in our community.
- We will actively work for meaningful, humane immigration reform.
- We will continue to build bridges of understanding and love, linking ourselves, immigrants in our community, and our broader community.
